The 50th Anniversary of the first descent and major expedition of the Blue Nile in Ethiopia is to be commemorated at the Royal Geographical Society, London 6.00 – 9.00pm on Tuesday 2nd October



2018. Said to be one of the great expeditions of the last century it was described by the Daily Telegraph as the conquest of the Everest of Rivers. An exhibition of

equipment will include one of the original
Avon white water boats and items used on the

led the team and
